<u>Tickets</u> - Enclosed, please find your High Holy Day 5786 tickets. We've included your member tickets as well as any additional tickets you may have purchased. For the safety and security of our congregants and guests, tickets are <u>required</u> for all services except where otherwise noted in the High Holiday booklet.

<u>Participating Online</u> - Each service will be livestreamed. Use your web browser of choice (Chrome, Safari, Microsoft Edge, etc.) and go to the links below for the services a few minutes prior to the start of each service. **ALL** services will be broadcast to a specific web address which will be emailed to congregants 1-2 weeks prior to the start of the High Holidays.

<u>Books</u> – If you plan to participate from home, you may pick up a set of books in the Adath office from Monday, September 15 – Friday, September 19 from 9:00 am – 3:00 pm. <u>All borrowed books must be returned by October 10</u>. If they are not returned you will be billed \$72/set. If you previously purchased books, please bring them with you if you plan to attend in person.

<u>Parking</u> - Parking will be available in our parking lot. Parking is not allowed on either Hainesport-Mount Laurel Road or Elbo Lane as cars will be ticketed. Please be respectful of our neighbors.

<u>Quiet Room</u> – The library will be available for those with small children that may need a break during the service. The service will be broadcast in the library.
