We hope that you are having a great summer. It is hard to believe that the High Holy Days are already approaching. This year's High Holy Day services will take place in-person and streamed online for those unable or not ready to gather. We look forward to joining in a communal experience that will surely lift the heart.

Note: Our plan for in-person services is based on Adath's current policy. There are several variables that can still change our plans. We will communicate with you should adaptations need to be made.

We have enclosed detailed information in this mailing. There are a few items we would like to highlight:

- Tickets will be mailed to all members in good standing on **September 16**.
- We are pleased to continue our policy that all attendees under the age of 23 years old do not need a ticket if accompanied by a member with a ticket.
- Tickets are available for purchase to our members for those relatives who are over 23 years of age, and members of the wider community. Purchased tickets are valid for both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur.
- As always, there is no restriction on children attending services in our sanctuary. However, children must be seated with their parents and are expected to respect the atmosphere of High Holy Day prayer and reflection. The library will be set up as a quiet space should you need to take your child out of the service, and babysitting is available for a charge.
- For children in grades K-6 we will have a youth service and programming, which will be available during the Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur-morning services.
